Please be advised that the San Joaquin County Environmental Health Department (EHD) received and approved a Report of Composting Site (RCSI) amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Scotts Hyponex Regional Composting Facility. The EHD is the Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for this facility. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites in San Joaquin County.

Description of Project and LEA's Determination

The Scotts Hyponex Regional Composting Facility is a 22-acre existing composting site located at 23390 E Flood Road between Fine Road and Escalon Bellota Road. On February 12, 2007, the LEA received a

Solid Waste Facility Permit package from the Hyponex Corporation applying for a RCSI amendment.

The site is a green material composting facility that currently composts yard trimmings which include leaves, grass and tree trimmings. The amendment adds the following new compost feedstocks: rice hulls, grape pumice, paper fiber, chicken manure and steer manure.

The EHD finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act documents, is consistent with the State Minimum Standards for Composting Facilities and does not conflict with the terms and conditions of the SWFP. The EHD approved the amendment on February 28, 2007.
