Introduction

Please be advised that the San Joaquin County Environmental Health Department (EHD) received and approved a modification to the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for the Scotts Hyponex Regional Composting Facility. This public notice is distributed as specified for modified SWFPs in Title 27 California Code of Regulations (T27 CCR) §21660.3(b). The EHD is the Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for this facility. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites in San Joaquin County.

Description of Project and LEA's Determination

The Scotts Hyponex Regional Composting Facility is a 22-acre existing composting site located at 23390 E Flood Road between Fine Road and Escalon Bellota Road. The site is a green material composting

facility that processes the following materials: leaves, grass, tree trimmings, rice hulls, grape pumice, paper fiber, chicken manure and steer manure. On May 22, 2007, the LEA received a SWFP package from the Hyponex Corporation applying for a modification to the SWFP. The permit modifications consist of updates to the California state regulations referenced by the SWFP and typos in the SWFP.

The EHD finds that the proposed permit changes qualify for a modified SWFP since the changes are nonmaterial changes as specified in T27 CCR §21563(d)(5). The EHD approved the modified SWFP on June 22, 2007.
