## **Aboveground Petroleum Storage Act Fee Proposal Workshop**

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In 2007, passage of Senate Bill 1130 (Laird) transferred the responsibility for the implementation, enforcement, and administration of the Aboveground Petroleum Storage Act and the regulation of certain aboveground petroleum storage facilities from the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) to local Certified Unified Program Agencies (CUPAs). Existing CUPA programs include California Accidental Release Prevention (CalARP), Hazardous Material Management Plans (Business Plans), Hazardous Waste Generators, Hazardous Waste Treatment (Tiered Permitting), and Underground Storage Tanks.

As the CUPA for San Joaquin County, the Environmental Health Department is currently developing the Aboveground Petroleum Storage Act (APSA) inspection program and will be establishing Environmental Health operating permit fees for APSA facilities. The proposed APSA program fees would take effect on January 1, 2010. In addition, an adjustment to the hourly rate service fee for all Environmental Health programs is proposed.

A meeting to discuss these proposals with aboveground petroleum storage owners and operators, as well as members of the general public, has been set for **Thursday, May 14, 2009, at 1:30 p.m.** The meeting will be held at the San Joaquin County Environmental Health Department office located at 600 E. Main Street (corner of Main and American Streets), Stockton, California.

The proposed program fees are shown below and will be discussed at the meeting. This opportunity for public and industry comment is being provided in preparation for the public fee hearing to be held before the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors, tentatively scheduled for June 25, 2009, in the Board Chambers, 7<sup>th</sup> Floor of the County Courthouse, 222 E. Weber Avenue, Stockton, California.
