## Small Water System Operator Expense Reimbursement Grant

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH), in partnership with Cooperative Personnel Services (CPS) Human Resource Services, is offering the Expense Reimbursement Grant Program, under a grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. This grant reimburses small water system operators for attending training to qualify for and take the operator certification exams and to complete the continuing education requirement for renewing certification. In addition, you can request specific training in your area. You may be eligible for this program if you meet the following:

- You are employed by a water system serving a population of 3,300 or less, and
- Your water system is designated community or non-transient/non-community by CDPH.
