This is the eighth weekly news bulletin on cases of West Nile Virus in San Joaquin County. Human and horse cases are posted to the county web site as they are confirmed. All bulletins are posted to the county web site. These bulletins will continue through the month of October.

HUMAN CASES

There are no new human cases of WNV in San Joaquin County as of 10-12-05. When last reported to the media on 10-7, the county had a total of 36 human cases.

HORSE CASES

There is one new WNV infected horse case, zip code 95366, since the news release of 10-7. This horse was alive at the time of reporting. The total number of horse cases is 19, with 9 dead or euthanized.

SENTINEL CHICKEN FLOCKS

There are no new WNV-positive chicken flocks. As reported last week, chickens in 6 out of 6 Sentinel Chicken flocks have tested positive for WNV. The flocks are located at Linden, Roberts Island, Staten Island, White Slough (Lodi), Division Rd. (Manteca), and Camanche.

POSITIVE MOSQUITO TEST GROUPS

There are no new WNV-positive collected mosquito groups as of 10-12. As reported last week, there are 38 groups of mosquitoes that have tested positive for WNV in 11 zip codes.
