(SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, STOCKTON, CA) - In response to the week-long heat wave, several cities within San Joaquin County have established Cooling Centers. Cooling Centers are cooled facilities for individuals needing relief from the heat. A list of the Cooling Centers along with their hours of service is attached.

The San Joaquin County Human Services staff continues to call clients at high risk to confirm their safety from the heat. The contacts include education regarding the importance of hydration, information on Cooling Centers and self-cooling tips if air conditioning is not available, and encouragement to use existing air conditioning.
