- SJC OES consolidated information on cooling centers in the OA and posted it on the website.
 - SJC OES updated volunteer emergency medical shelter list (backup facilities for home health care providers).
 - SJC OES updating contact list of home health care providers.
 - Meals-on-Wheels (Senior's First) personnel are monitoring their clients.
 - SJ County HSA is checking on the services being provided by all licensed care facilities in the county
 - HSA Department of Aging and Community Services is distributing literature "Heat Tips for the Elderly."
 - Catholic Charities is collecting donations of fans, air conditioners, water & blue ice.
 - Love I.N.C. members are available to provide transportation to cooling centers.
 - City of Escalon Police Department has been checking on senior mobile home parks in Escalon and providing contact information for emergencies.
 - City of Ripon reports that they are providing extra water to their employees.
 - Cities of Tracy, Stockton, Lodi, & Lathrop in addition to the County have opened cooling centers.
 - Stockton Shelters are accepting anyone who needs help in their air conditioned facilities or taking them to air conditioned public libraries.
 - County and city Information Officers are coordinating their efforts to keep the public informed.
 - PG&E public assistance information has been posted on the OES website
