## SITUATION SUMMARY

07/27/2006 at 23:22 PDT San Joaquin PI 7-Operational Area

On July 23rd, St. Joseph's Hospital in Stockton reported the death of a patient from the Beverly Healthcare Convalescent Home admitted with heat-related symptoms. It was found that the Home's air conditioning system had failed and all residents were evacuated to area hospitals and other care facilities.

On July 24th, the San Joaquin County Sheriff/Coroner reported that the morgue was full and requested extra refrigeration facilities.

The cities of Lathrop and Lodi opened cooling centers for seniors beginning on July 24th. Lodi Memorial Hospital specifically requested a cooling center be opened for the community due to suspected heat-related deaths and the number of patients in the ICU admitted due to heat-related causes.

On July 25th, the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors proclaimed a Local Emergency due to the unprecedented July heat experience over the past several days and its potential impact on the health and safety of humans, and the County's agricultural industry, including both livestock and produce.

A Disaster Relief Coalition of public and private non-profit agencies was formed to coordinate efforts within the operational area.

On July 25th, the SJ County Agricultural Commissioner estimated that 120 heifers per day were dying in addition to currently unknown numbers of turkeys and other livestock. Crop damages are expected, especially to walnuts, grapes & tomatoes.

Power went out to two trailer parks overnight on July 25th for 3-4 hours.

Additional cooling centers have been opened throughout San Joaquin County. As of July 27th there were 14 cooling centers opened serving approximately 165 residents. In addition, shelters and community centers report that approx 330 of their regular clients have extra needs because of the extreme heat. County HSA reports the following statistics:

62,000 seniors above the age of 65 yrs

3,000 at 90+ yrs

5,000 at 85-90 yrs

8,500 at 80+

PG&E reports that there have been no supply shortages. Short term power outages have occurred in the county due to equipment overheating. Normally, the equipment would cool off overnight, but hasn't been able to do so due to high temperatures and high demand.
