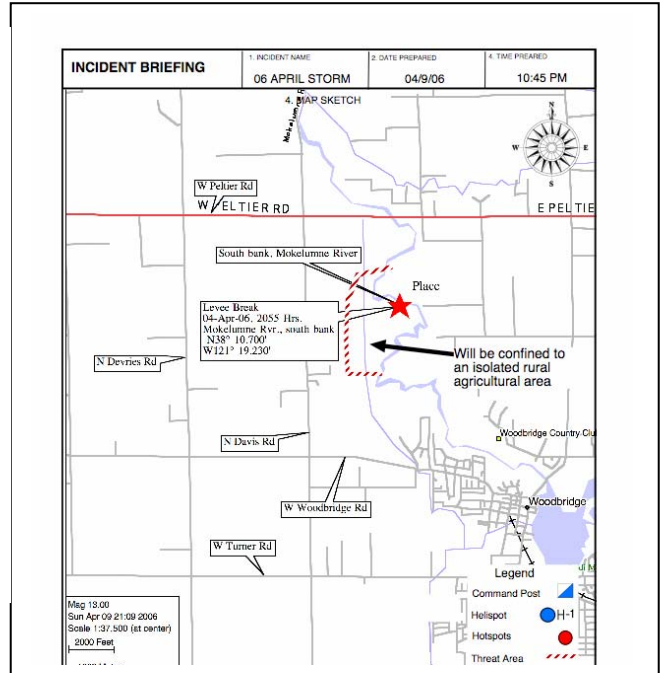
Emergency Operations Center – Staffing Level: **I**

## CURRENT SITUATION:

San Joaquin County EOC notified at 20:06 by a member of the public of a break in the south side levee of the Mokelumne River, northwest of Woodbridge. Requested SJC Sheriff department to confirm report. Sheriff dept o/s confirmed levee break at 21:16. CHP helicopter overhead also verified break. Break 30-40 feet in length at 38, 10.7 N, 121, 19.23 W. OES Area Command Liaison o/s determined break to be in private levee within flood plain and is expected to flood only an orchard. The main levee along the river bank is not affected and continues to hold the river flow. County emergency services to continue to monitor situation. Resources and material from activity in the southern San Joaquin County are not effected.
