ONE-DAY DISASTER ASSISTANCE CENTER SET UP FOR JONES TRACT FLOOD VICTIMS

(Stockton, CA) — San Joaquin County Office of Emergency Services is hosting a one-day Disaster Assistance Center for the Jones Tract flood victims on Wednesday, September 1 at the Public Health Auditorium at 1601 E. Hazelton Avenue, Stockton.

A number of county and non-county agencies will be on site to provide information and assistance. Non-county agencies will include the United States Department of Agriculture and Pacific Gas & Electric Company. County agencies will include the Assessor's Office, Public Health, Environmental Health, Public Works, Community Development, and the Agricultural Commissioner's Office.

Farmers, property owners, land owners and other people who have been impacted by the Jones Tract Flood can drop in during the hours of 1 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. to ask questions about any issue that may have arisen due to the flood, including obtaining new building permits and the assessed value of property.

Hazelton Avenue is located off Wilson Way, south of the Hwy 4/Crosstown Freeway. Parking is free.
