This is the tenth and last weekly news bulletin on cases of West Nile Virus in San Joaquin County for 2005. There have been no new reported cases of WNV in San Joaquin County in humans, horses, sentinel chicken flocks, or mosquito test groups. Human and horse cases have been posted to the county web site as they are confirmed. All weekly bulletins have been posted to the county web site. The total number of WNV cases in 2005 in humans remains at 36.

HUMAN CASES

There are no new human cases of WNV in San Joaquin County. When last reported to the media on 10-21, the county had a total of 36 human cases. No new human cases have been reported since October 7.

HORSE CASES

There are no new WNV infected horse cases. The total number of horse cases remains at 19, with 9 dead or euthanized.

SENTINEL CHICKEN FLOCKS

There are no new WNV-positive chicken flocks. As last reported, chickens in 6 out of 6 Sentinel Chicken flocks have tested positive for WNV. The flocks are located at Linden, Roberts Island, Staten Island, White Slough (Lodi), Division Rd. (Manteca), and Camanche.

POSITIVE MOSQUITO TEST GROUPS

There are no new WNV-positive collected mosquito groups. As last reported, there are 38 groups of mosquitoes that have tested positive for WNV in 11 zip codes.
