**MEMBERSHIP,  
QUALIFICATIONS,

REQUIREMENTS:** Qualifications are set forth in Revenue and Taxation Code Section  
1624. A minimum of 5 years professional experience in this State  
as one of the following: certified public accountant or public  
accountant; licensed real estate broker; attorney; property appraiser  
accredited by a nationally recognized professional organization; or  
is a person who the nominating member of the Board of  
Supervisors has reason to believe is possessed of competent  
knowledge of property appraisal and taxation.

**TERM:** 3 Year Terms.

**DUTIES:** Equalization of taxable value of property.
