## Homeowners' Exemption Termination Notice

You must notify the Assessor whenever a property you own is no longer eligible for the Homeowner's Exemption. The notification should be no later than the first December 10 following the lien date (January 1) immediately following your vacating the property. Failure to notify the Assessor will result in escape assessments and penalties if an unauthorized exemption is discovered. A dwelling does not qualify for the exemption if it is, or is intended to be, rented, vacant/unoccupied, or the vacation or secondary home of the claimant or if you do not own it.

This document is for you to notify the Assessor that you are no longer eligible for the Homeowners' Exemption. Please mark the following reason(s) and provide the date(s) when the change occurred:
