- NO INSPECTIONS WILL BE MADE UNLESS **PLANS AND PERMIT** ARE AT THE JOBSITE.
- TO REQUEST AN INSPECTION: PLEASE CALL <u>209/468-3165</u>. AN AUTOMATIC RECORDING DEVICE HAS BEEN INSTALLED TO RECEIVE INSPECTION REQUESTS. THIS SERVICE WILL BE AVAILABLE 24 HOURS A DAY, SEVEN DAYS A WEEK. THE CALLS WILL BE TAKEN OFF THE RECORDER AT 3:00 P.M. EVERY WEEKDAY AND DISTRIBUTED FOR INSPECTION ON THE FOLLOWING <u>WORKDAY</u>.
- ALL JOBSITES MUST BE CLEARLY POSTED WITH THE SITE ADDRESS ON LOT OR STRUCTURE AND ON ACCESS ROAD IF APPLICABLE.

Following is a list of <u>TYPICAL INSPECTIONS FOR WOOD FRAME CONSTRUCTION ONLY</u>. Other types of construction may need other types of inspections. Contact this Division for further information.

**<u>ROUGH PLUMBING PRIOR TO SLAB</u>**: Inspected before concrete slab is placed or before the subfloor is applied covering the plumbing. <u>**UNDERFLOOR SUBSTRUCTURE**</u> and <u>**DUCTS**</u> are also checked.

**FORMS**: Inspected to determine that the structure is located according to the approved Plot Plan and that the foundation will meet minimum requirements. Steel and/or mesh to be in place.

**<u>ROOF SHEATHING</u>**: Inspected for type, grade and nailing; roof structure checked.

**SHEARWALL/BRACEWALL**: Inspector to verify property size, spacing, and attachment of hardware and verify attachment to framing.

**<u>ROUGH</u>**: Inspected at this point are the **<u>FRAME</u>**, window sizes, **<u>STUCCO WIRE</u>**/weep screen, **<u>ELECTRICAL</u>** wiring, **<u>PLUMBING</u>** vents, flue vents and ducts. Inspection is to be made before the insulation is installed. All permit cards must be signed in appropriate spaces prior to interior wall cover application. **<u>SPECIFY INSPECTIONS</u> <u>REQUIRED WHEN YOU CALL</u>**.

FIREPLACE: Inspection of footing for size and reinforcement; firebox and throat; flue and vertical reinforcement; final.

**INSULATION**: Inspected before interior wall covering applied. Certificate of Installation to be posted by time of final inspection.

**<u>SHEETROCK NAILING</u>**: Inspected for type (bath areas, one hour construction), nailing and support.

**ELECTRICAL SERVICE**: Inspected for overhead conductor clearances, type and securing of equipment, wire and conduit size, grounding and bonding, construction GFI breaker and receptacle, domestic pump isolation breaker.

<u>GAS TEST</u>: Requires air pressure gauge test for the inspector's observation; ten pound air test for metal pipe, sixty pound air test of that portion that is plastic pipe. <u>GAS SERVICE</u>: One gas appliance must be connected.

**FINAL INSPECTION**: At this point, gas and electric services are in. Inspected are gas appliances, electric fixture installations, attic insulation, weather-stripping, grading, and any other items pertinent to occupancy. Occupying a building prior to a final approval constitutes a violation of San Joaquin County Ordinance Code, punishable as a misdemeanor. **SPECIFY BUILDING, PLUMBING, MECHANICAL** and/or **ELECTRICAL WHEN YOU CALL FOR INSPECTION**.

## PERMIT BECOMES VOID IF WORK IS NOT STARTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OR IF WORK IS ABANDONED FOR 180 DAYS.
