SUBJECT: Rescinded San Joaquin County EMS Policy Memorandums

No. 2021- 01, No. 2021-02, and No. 2021-03

The purpose of this memorandum is to rescind the following SJCEMSA policy memorandums:

- 1. No. 2021-01, Coronavirus (COVID-19) Authorization for General Acute Care Hospitals to Employ and Use Prehospital Care Personnel (Revised).
- 2. No. 2021-02, Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccine Administration by Paramedics.
- 3. No. 2021-03, Coronavirus (COVID-19) Vaccine Administration by Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT).

Pursuant to the termination of the Governor's executive orders of N-11-22 and N-4-22, effective March 1, 2023, paramedics and EMT personnel are no longer authorized to administer testing and vaccinations for Covid-19, Monkeypox, and the flu. This includes the termination of the authorization for EMS Personnel to perform their scope at static sites. Please review EMSA Memorandums dated 02-01-23 and 10-17-22 for background and clarification regarding this rescission.
