Please be advised that the San Joaquin County Environmental Health Department (EHD) received and approved a Transfer Processing Report (TPR) amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Lovelace Transfer Station. The EHD is the Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for this facility. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites in San Joaquin County.

Description of Project and LEA's Determination

Lovelace Transfer Station is a 15-acre existing transfer station located at 2323 Lovelace Road west of Union Road, north of Manteca. On August 27, 2007, the LEA received a Solid Waste Facility Permit package from the San Joaquin County Department of Public Works applying for a TPR amendment.

The amendment proposes to relocate the Collection/Staging/Processing area for appliances, refrigerant units, and universal waste. The Appliance Collection/Staging/Processing Area proposes to locate at the southeast corner of the transfer building. Refrigeration units are staged on the tipping floor near the metals processing area on the general public self haul side of the transfer building. Non-refrigeration units, such as washers and dryers, are staged in the appliance processing area on the tipping floor. The Recycling Materials Staging/Secondary Processing Area south of the station is used as a secondary staging area for appliance processing to allow for flexibility in times of overflow. The change will allow the facility to operate at a higher level of efficiency.

The EHD finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act documents, is consistent with the State Minimum Standards for Transfer/Processing Facilities and does not conflict with the terms and conditions of the SWFP. The EHD approved the amendment on October 3, 2007.
