Please be advised that the San Joaquin County Environmental Health Department (EHD) received and approved a Joint Technical Document (JTD) amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the North County Recycling Center & Sanitary Landfill. The EHD is the Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for this facility. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites in San Joaquin County, including active and closed landfills.

Description of Project and LEA's Determination

North County Recycling Center & Sanitary Landfill is a 320-acre existing landfill site located at 17900 E Harney Lane between Jack Tone Road and Clements Road. On November 22, 2006, the LEA received a

Solid Waste Facility Permit package from the San Joaquin County Department of Public Works applying for a JTD amendment.

The amendment adds the operation of a Caterpillar 825C Compactor to compact waste on the tipping floor of the Recycling Center before it is transported to the landfill. The compactor will operate in a designated location and all personnel will leave the tipping floor while the compactor is operating. A line of concrete K-rails will be placed between the compactor and self-haul unloading area to protect personnel and customers from explosion hazards.

The EHD finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act documents, is consistent with the State Minimum Standards for Transfer/Processing Facilities and does not conflict with the terms and conditions of the SWFP. The EHD approved the amendment on February 7, 2006.
