Please be advised that the San Joaquin County Environmental Health Department Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and has approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Forward Inc. Landfill. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) to enforce state law and regulations at the solid waste sites within the County of San Joaquin, excluding the City of Stockton, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of the Project and the LEA's Determination

The Forward Inc. Landfill is a permitted 567-acre existing landfill site located at 9999 S. Austin Road, Manteca. The Resource Recovery Facility is co-located on the same property as the landfill. On July 24, 2009, the LEA received a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package proposing to amend the Report of Compost Site Information (RCSI) and updating the Transfer Processing Report

(TPR) as part of the 5 year Permit Review. The application was accepted as complete on August 19, 2009. The changes to the RCSI are minor and center on making the information current. The composting portion of the facility has been inactive since February 2005. The site operations that were previously approved were scaled back to include only windrow type composting (no in-vessel). The TPR was updated as part of the 5 year permit review. Those changes included updates to the IIPP and Emergency Contacts list. There are no other changes to SWPF under consideration at this time.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA approved the amendment on August 19, 2009.
