Please be advised that the San Joaquin County Environmental Health Department Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and has approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Forward Inc. Landfill. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) to enforce state law and regulations at the solid waste sites within the County of San Joaquin, excluding the City of Stockton, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of the Project and the LEA's Determination

The Forward Inc. Landfill is a permit 567-acre existing landfill site located at 9999 S. Austin Road, Manteca. On February 3, 2007, The LEA received the propose amendment form the Forward Inc. Landfill a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the RFI requesting that the ADC and Beneficial Reuse materials being accepted at the site be tracked, and that the limits placed on the amounts accepted be capped by material type. The cap on the materials was partially derived from an onsite demonstration that is also a part of the amendment. The demonstration project allowed the operator to establish baseline information for the amount of material reused onsite. There are not other changes to SWPF under consideration at this time.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA approved the amendment on February 15, 2007.
