The Escalon Fire District is accepting applications for one Battalion Chief to be in-charge of the Training and Fire Operations Division. The position will be assigned to a 56-hour work week. The Battalion Chief will also be responsible for supervision of personnel assigned to his or her 24-hour shift, acting as incident commander as appropriate, as well as general firefighting and emergency response duties.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Ten years fire service experience, of which five must be as a full-time firefighter
- Minimum of three years as a full-time Fire Captain or other shift supervisor
- Possession of CA State Fire Officer Certificate or the ability to obtain within two years of appointment.
- Certification as a California certified Firefighter 1
- Emergency Medical Technician 1
- Hazmat First Responder Operations
- Possession of a California Class “B” Firefighters Drivers License
- Experience and thorough knowledge of Fire Training and Operations

- State certified fire instructor
- Hazardous Materials Technician or Specialist
- Chief Officer certification
- Associates degree of higher from an accredited college in Fire Science, business administration, or closely related field
