## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to prepare the registered nurse with emergency nursing experience to take the Mobile Intensive Care Nurse (MICN) authorization examination in San Joaquin County.

### Course Objectives:

Upon completion of the MICN course, participants will be able to:

- Describe the role of the MICN.
- Identify the prehospital management of patients who present with various medical and trauma emergencies.
- Describe the scope of practice of all levels of prehospital providers.
- Effectively simulate communication between field and base hospital personnel.

### Course Prerequisites:

Course participants must provide verification of the following course prerequisites.

- Active California R.N. license.
- AHA ACLS course completion.
- Six months of emergency department experience within the past two years.
- Completion of NIMS 700 or HICS course.
