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SUBJ.: New Med Net Radio Frequencies (Transmit and Receive)

The San Joaquin County Med Net Communication replacement project will entail the implementation of new UHF med-net frequencies and PL Tones at each receiving hospital and the county base hospital at San Joaquin General Hospital. All ambulance and ALS first response providers will need to make arrangements to have mobile and portable radios reprogrammed with the new frequencies and PLs. The EMS Agency will be notifying providers as the project vendor Delta Wireless schedules each hospital's installation. All installs are expected to be complete by August 31, 2007.
