## **Course Description**

This program provides the core-level pre-hospital knowledge and psychomotor skills associated with the delivery of professional EMT care to the patient with medical emergencies and/or trauma-related emergencies.

## **Course Objectives:**

On completion of this course, the participant should be able to:

- Recognize the nature & seriousness of the patient's condition or extent of injuries to assess requirements for emergency medical care
- Administer appropriate emergency care based on assessment findings of the patient's condition
- Lift, move, position, and otherwise handle the patient to minimize discomfort and prevent further injury.
- Perform safely and effectively the expectations of the job description.
- Understand the importance of documentation and CQI process to the EMT.
