COURSE DESCRIPTION

This program provides the core-level trauma knowledge and psychomotor skills associated with the delivery of professional nursing care to the patient with trauma.

Course Objectives:

On completion of this course, the participant should be able to:

- Identify the common mechanisms of injury associated with trauma.
- Describe the pathophysiologic changes as a basis for signs and symptoms.
- Describe the nursing assessment of patients with trauma.
- Describe the appropriate interventions for patients with trauma.
- Describe mechanisms for evaluating the effectiveness of nursing interventions for patients with trauma.

Course Prerequisites:

In order to maximize success in the TNCC course it is recommended that the participant have at least six months experience as a registered nurse in an emergency care setting.
