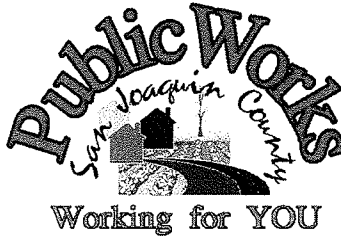




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PREPAID DEPOSIT PLAN

All users of San Joaquin County (County) disposal sites (Foothill Sanitary Landfill, North County Recycling Center and Sanitary Landfill, and Lovelace Materials Recovery Facility and Transfer Station) must pay a cash disposal fee, except for those who have been authorized to use the Prepaid Deposit Plan.

The Prepaid Deposit Plan required that non-cash customers pay an advance deposit in order to use the County disposal site without paying cash disposal fees. This enables the customer to "draw" from the account during the month as waste is brought to the site.

The County will keep a monthly record of the waste quantities disposed and the corresponding disposal fees. At the end of each month, the County will subtract that total monthly disposal fee from the advance deposit. The customer will then be billed the total monthly disposal fee, to replenish the advance deposit. Payment is due in the Solid Waste office by the end of the month in which the bill is submitted.

The amount of deposit required (for each disposal site used) is determined by the following schedule:

\$0 - 50	\$150
50 -150	450
150 - 300	600
300 - 500	1,000
500 - 1,000	2,000
	Minimum of \$3,000 OR
Over \$1,000	Average monthly charge Rounded to nearest \$100

The County will **periodically review** the monthly disposal fees and adjust the amount of advance deposit accordingly.

Customers will **not** be allowed to use the County disposal site if the advance deposit funds have been exhausted or have habitually fallen below the required deposit amount. **If you choose to establish an account at more than one site, a separate deposit and application is required for each site.**

In order to use County disposal sites on a non-cash basis, please complete the application form and return with your check for the required deposit amount. We are unable to establish your account until the deposit is received at our office.
