COMPENSATION: None.

LEGAL AUTHORITY: Board Order B-73-1289 and Resolution R-73-1463 dated June 26, 1973 directed the CAO to develop a plan to implement an Affirmative Action Advisory Committee; Board Order B-91-1835 dated November 26, 1991 increased the number of Community Representatives from 7 to 12 and raised the total number of members from 11 to 16; Board Order B-98-500 dated April 28, 1998 changed the name of the committee to Equal Employment Opportunity Advisory Committee (EEOAC) and Board Order B-00-1309 dated October 24, 2000 which adopted the EEO Plan.

MEMBERSHIP, QUALIFICATIONS, & RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS: 9 Members:
7 Community At-Large Representatives
1 Department Head or Assistant Department Head Nominated by the County Administrator
1 Employee Representative Nominated by the County Administrator

TERM: 2 Year Terms.

COMMITTEE FACT SHEET

NAME: **SJC MOSQUITO & VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT**

COMPENSATION: Per Health & Safety Code §2030 (b), the members of the board of trustees may receive their actual and necessary traveling and incidental expenses incurred while on official business. In lieu of paying for actual expenses, the board of trustees may by resolution provide for the allowance any payment to each trustee a sum not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) per month for expenses incurred while on official business.

LEGAL AUTHORITY: Resolution and Order of Consolidation adopted on January 22, 1980; Health & Safety Code §2000-2007, §2010-2014, §2020-2030, and §2040-2055; San Joaquin County Mosquito and Vector Control District Board of Trustees' Resolution 07/08-3 Adopted February 19, 2008 and Resolution R-08-236 Adopted April 29, 2008.

MEMBERSHIP, QUALIFICATIONS, & RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS: Four (4) members appointed by the Board of Supervisors and seven (7) members appointed by the incorporated cities. Each person appointed by the Board of Supervisors shall be a voter in San Joaquin County and a resident of that portion of the county that is within the district; each person appointed by a city council shall be a voter in that city and a resident of that portion of the city that is within the district.

TERM: 2 or 4 Year Terms, at the discretion of the appointing authority. Terms of office commence at noon on the first Monday of January.

DUTIES: Per H&S Code §2040 and §2041, the district may take any and all necessary or proper actions to prevent vectors and vector borne diseases; take any and all necessary or proper actions to abate or control vectors and vector borne diseases; to purchase the supplies and materials, employ the personnel, and contract for the services that may be necessary or proper to carry out the purposes and intent of this chapter of the H&S Code.
