- MEMBERSHIP, QUALIFICATIONS, & RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS:** Eleven (11) Members and Three (3) Alternate Members appointed by the Board of Supervisors:
- a) Six (6) members who live or work in San Joaquin County who are past or present users of personal assistance services, of which:
    - All six (6) must be past or present users of public or private personal assistance services; a minimum of three (3) committee members to be past or present users of public personal assistance services.
  - b) Two (2) members will be current or former providers of in-home supportive services.
  - c) Three (3) members, who live or work in San Joaquin County, to be selected from the specific categories indicated below.

  - d) All applicants will be screened by the Human Services Agency for verification that the individual possesses the necessary requirement for that category. Human Services Agency staffs committee and acts as lead agency on projects.
- TERM:** 3 Year Terms. Initial appointments staggered so that six members have a Two Year term, and five members have a Three Year Term.
- DUTIES:** Submit recommendations to the County Board of Supervisors on the preferred service delivery mode(s) to be utilized by the County for the provision of in-home supportive services. Provide ongoing advice and recommendations regarding in-home supportive services to the County Board of Supervisors, any administrative body in the county that is related to the delivery and administration of in-home supportive services, and the governing body and administrative agency of the public authority, non-profit consortium, contractor and public employees.

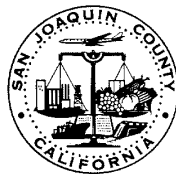
