PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A Minor Subdivision application to subdivide a 122.25 acre lot into 4 lots and a Designated Remainder. Lot 1 to contain 11.14 acres. Lot 2 to contain 4.63 acres. Lot 3 to contain 12.38 acres. Lot 4 to contain 32.38 acres. The Designated Remainder to contain approximately 62 acres. Lot 1 and the Designated Remainder are accessed from S. Holly Drive. Lot 3 is accessed from Arbor Avenue. Lots 2 and 3 are landlocked. Access for Lots 2 and 3 must be provided. Parking for all lots is contained on Lot 4. All lots receive water from the City of Tracy and utilize on site septic systems. Stormwater drainage is into Sugar Cut. This parcel is not under Williamson Act contract.

The Property is zoned I-G (General Industrial) and the General Plan designation is I/G (General Industrial).

PROJECT LOCATION: The project site is on the east side of S. Holly Drive, Tracy.. (APN/Address: 212-160-20 / 20512 S. Holly Dr., Tracy) (Supervisorial District: 5)
