

MIDDLE ROAD REPAIRS UPDATE

PRESS RELEASE

San Joaquin County Department of Public Works is pleased to announce that the slope repairs along Middle Road, between Naglee Road and west of Lammers Road, are nearing completion. The fiberglass sheet pile installation is complete and the roadway will be open to through traffic beginning later today, Friday, July 22, 2016. The remaining work, which consists of shoulder restoration and minor roadway repairs, will be performed under traffic control. During this work, drivers may experience minor delays through the immediate construction zone.

Completion of all remaining work is estimated to occur by July 31, 2016. The County appreciates the patience and cooperation of all constituents impacted by this slope repair project.

Due to funding constraints, this project only addressed the most significantly eroded sections of the slope. The County will continue to monitor the slope for degradation. Additional improvements will be completed, as necessary, and as funding allows.

The County's roadway resurfacing project is planned to occur in Spring 2017. Please see the contact information below for any questions you may have.
