

McHENRY AVENUE CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT
(Bird Netting Installation for Project Preparation)

Installation of Bird Netting, which is required in preparation for the McHenry Avenue Corridor Improvement Project, is scheduled to begin on January 9, 2017, depending on weather conditions. The Stanislaus River Bridge is a known nesting area, and birds are anticipated to return by the end of January 2017. Installation of bird netting must be completed prior to nesting season. As a result, Contractors will be working on/under the Stanislaus River Bridge to install the netting, which is intended to restrict birds from nesting under the structure. This work will take approximately four (4) weeks.

During this time, traffic will be restricted to a single lane with flagging. Travelers should expect delays of approximately 15 minutes , between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., when passing through the area. A Changeable Message Board is in place to notify travelers of pending work and time duration.
