 - Re-Inspections
 - Valid Complaint Inspections
- ◆ Requested Services
 - Plan Checks
 - Consultations

WHY ARE WE HERE TODAY?

■ *Annual Fee Review*

- All EHD program fees are reviewed each year as part of County budget process.
- Board of Supervisor Resolution B-90-620 policy endorsing full cost recovery.
- ◆ All EHD Fee Calculations based on:
 - ◆ Actual prior fiscal year department costs
 - ◆ Staff time spent on program-specific activity

WHY ARE WE HERE TODAY?

■ *Food Program*

- ◆ **Increased workload and inspection complexity**
 - CO₂ Inspections
 - School Inspections
 - Illegal Food Vendors
 - Food Recalls

■ *Hourly Rate*

- ◆ **All EHD charges are based on per hour fee**
- ◆ **Increased operating costs**

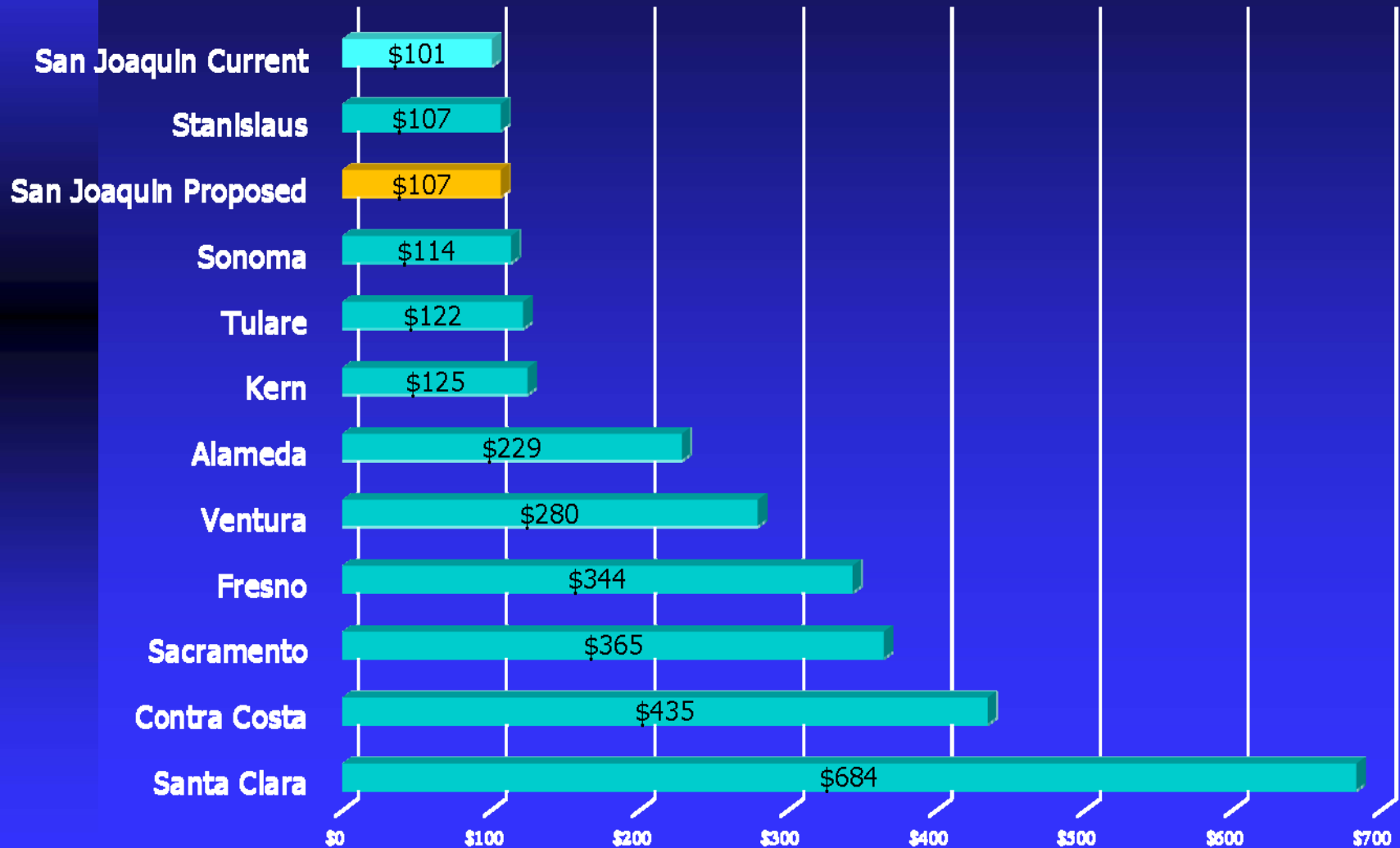

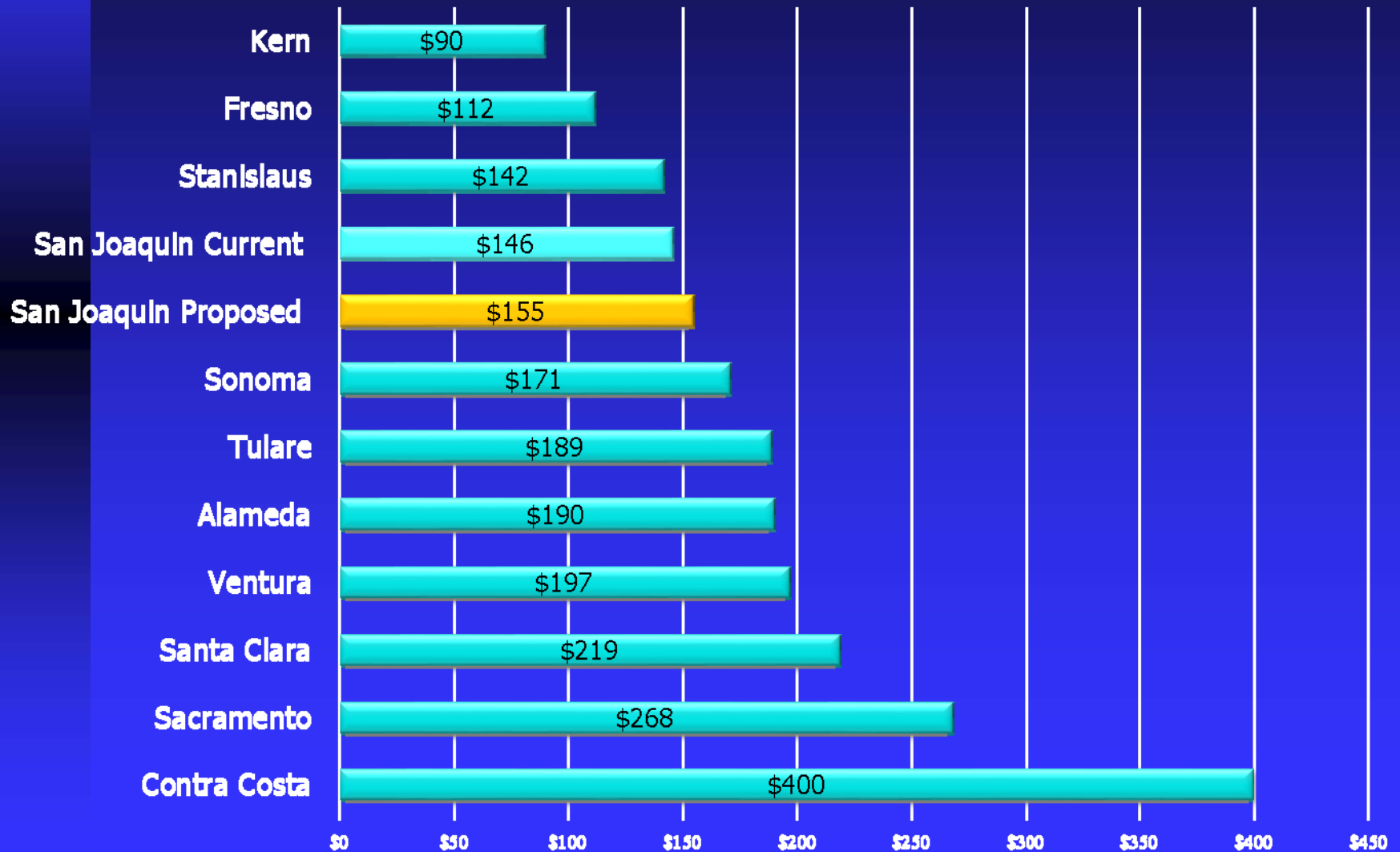

Produce Stands / Retail Markets



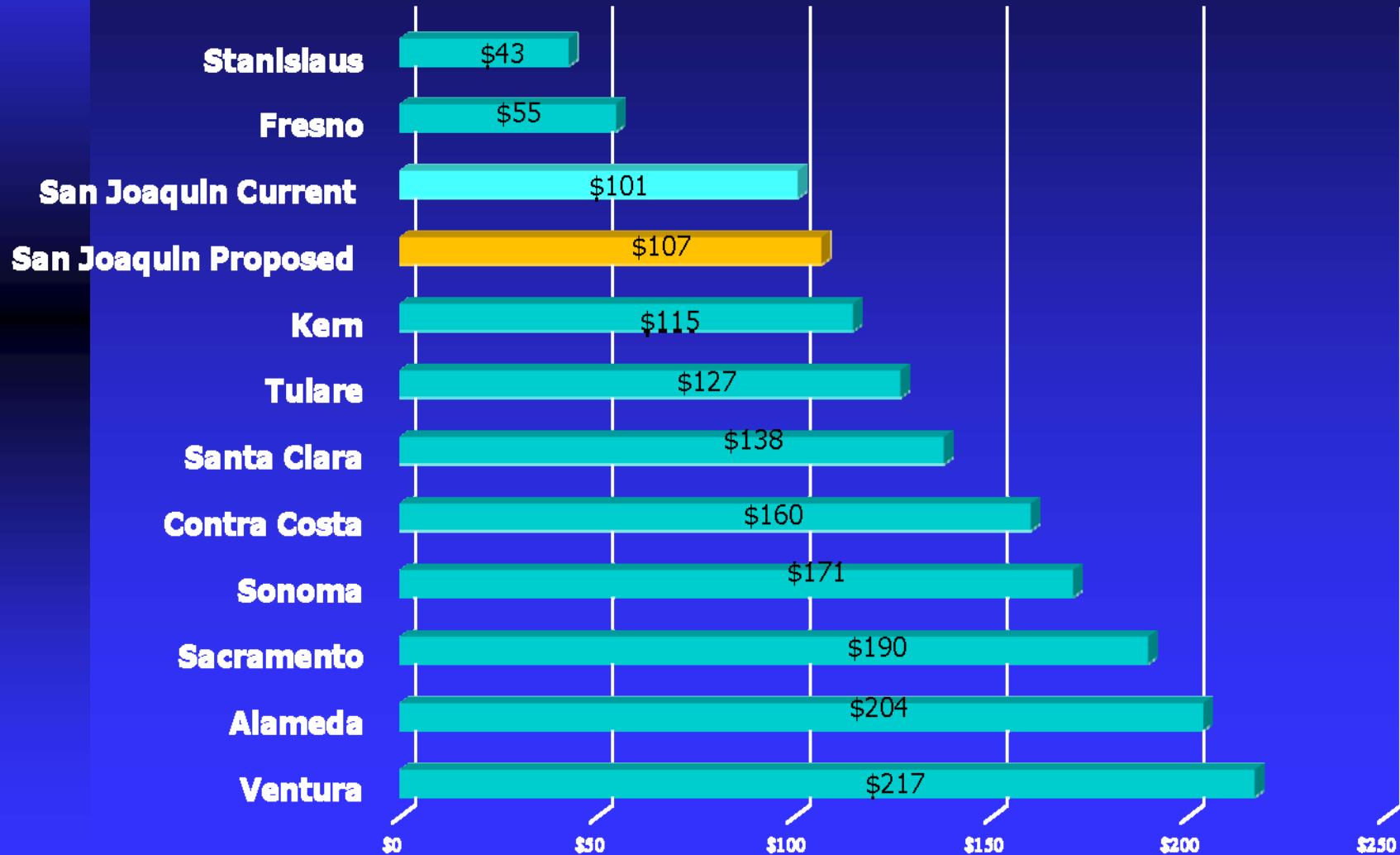

Cottage Food Operations



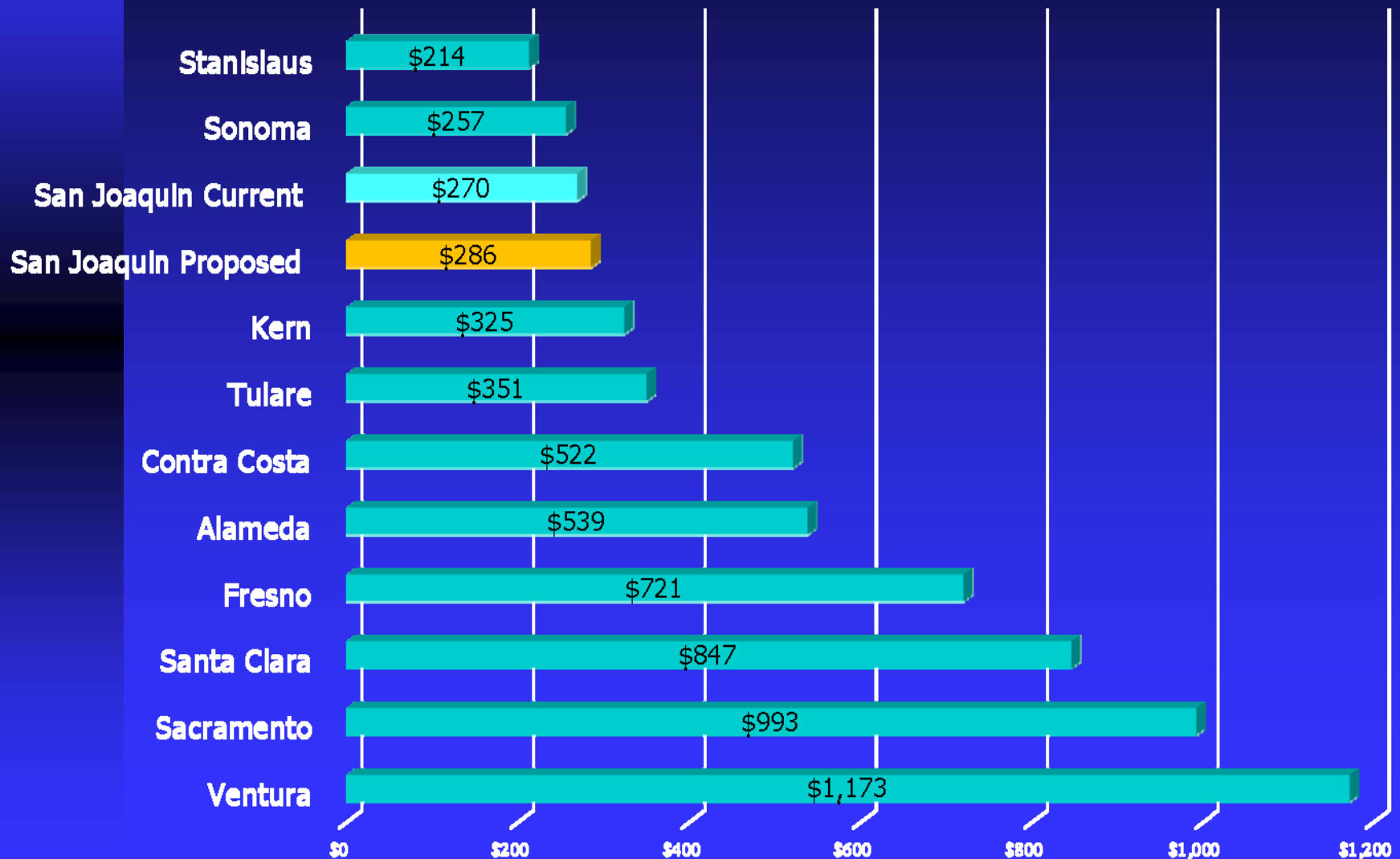

It is illegal to sell or give food to the public without a valid health permit (California Health and Safety Code, Section 114381). If you are selling food without a health permit, you must **STOP IMMEDIATELY**.

- *The Information Available here Includes:*
 - ◆ Name and address of the food facility
 - ◆ Date of the last activity – routine inspection, reinspection, change of ownership, or period of closure
 - ◆ Identification of major and minor violations in **RED** and **BLUE**
 - ◆ Brief examples of violations that were noted on the inspection
