Please be advised that the San Joaquin County Environmental Health Department (EHD) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Tracy Material Recovery & Transfer Facility. The EHD is the Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for this facility. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites in San Joaquin County.

Description of Project and LEA's Determination

Tracy Material Recovery & Transfer Facility is a 51.7-acre existing transfer station located at 30703 S. MacArthur Drive in unincorporated San Joaquin County, near the City of Tracy. On October 4, 2018, the LEA received a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package proposing to update the Report of Facility Information (RFI) as part of the 5 year Permit Review.

The amendment proposes to install a mechanized sorting line to the north side of the MRF building which is utilized for the processing of CDI and green waste; to construct an additional employee parking area at the northeastern portion of the site, adjacent to the facility entrance; to

relocate truck parking area to the southern expansion area; to expand the onsite wastewater and storm water retention basins in accordance with required capacities.

The proposed changes will not affect any other aspect of the facility operation and will allow the facility to operate at a higher level of efficiency.

The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA approved the amendment on October 9, 2018.
