**SUBJECT: PLACE OF DETENTION: 18 and 19 YEAR OLDS**

**POLICY**

Per section 208.5 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, “Notwithstanding any other law, in any case in which a minor (youth) is detained in or committed to a county institution established for the purpose of housing juveniles attains 18 years of age prior to or during the period of detention or confinement he or she may be allowed to come or remain in contact with those juveniles until 19 years of age.”...

**PROCEDURE**

A. The following applies to bookings by law enforcement agencies only and does not pertain to housing orders or jail commitments by the Juvenile Court.

<u>Situation</u>	<u>Disposition</u>
18 years old and a Juvenile Court Warrant or crime committed as juvenile. No adult charges	Book in Juvenile Detention
18 years old and a Juvenile Court Warrant and adult charges/Adult Warrant	Book Main Jail on adult charges and add juvenile 602 (WIC) Warrant hold
19 years old (or older) and a Juvenile Court Warrant or booked for a crime committed as a juvenile and NO adult charges or adult Warrant	Book in Main Jail as a courtesy hold for Juvenile Detention. Add juvenile 602 WIC Warrant hold
19 years of age (or older) and a Juvenile Court Warrant and adult charges/adult Warrant	Book in Main Jail for adult charges/Warrant. Add juvenile 602 WIC Warrant hold
