1% Manual Tally – November 3, 2020 Presidential General Election

Pursuant to State Law, during the official canvass of every election in which a voting system is used, a public manual tally of ballots tabulated by those devices shall be conducted. A manual tally of ballots cast in at least 1% of precincts, selected at random, will be conducted as part of the Post-Election canvass of this election.

The manual tally process, as are all components of the official canvass of results, is open to public observation.

The random selection of precincts to be manually tallied will begin on Saturday, November 21 at 8:30 a.m. Ballots for precincts selected will be retrieved Saturday, November 21 and Sunday, November 22.

The manual tally of the votes will begin on Monday, November 23 at 8:30 a.m.

All processes related to the 1% Manual Tally will be conducted in the Office of the Registrar of Voters located at 44 N. San Joaquin St., Suite 350, Stockton, CA 95202.

The manual tally will be conducted each day, until completed, during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. If needed, manual tally hours could be extended, including evenings until 8:00 p.m. and/or on weekends and holidays.

Due to COVID restrictions, anyone entering the building will have to wear a face covering. Please visit our website for updates on restrictions entering the building.
