- 1 representative from United States Natural Resource Conservation Service - Permanent Appointment
- 1 representative from Farm Service Agency - Permanent Appointment
- 1 representative from California Women for Agriculture
- 1 representative from an Ag related industry
- 1 representative from an Ag financing institution
- 1 representative from Delta College Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources
- 1 member of the Board of Supervisors to serve as ex-officio – Permanent Appointment
- 1 member of the Board of Supervisors to serve as alternate ex-officio - Permanent Appointment
