NAME: **ASSESSMENT APPEALS BOARD NUMBER 1;

COMPENSATION: Assessment Appeals Boards #1 and #2 - \$100.00 per three hour session, up to a maximum of \$200.00 per day; Assessment Hearing Officers - \$200.00 per hearing day.

LEGAL AUTHORITY: California Constitution, Article 13, Section 16; Revenue and Taxation Code Sections 1620 - 1630; Ordinance #3210 and Board Order B-85-1637 adopted September 17, 1985; Board Order B-92-1596 adopted September 25, 1992, Ordinance #4371 adopted June 16, 2009, and Board Order B-09-896 adopted August 11, 2009.

**MEMBERSHIP,
QUALIFICATIONS,
& RESIDENCY
REQUIREMENTS:** Qualifications are set forth in Revenue and Taxation Code Section 1624. A minimum of 5 years professional experience in this State as one of the following: certified public accountant or public accountant; licensed real estate broker; attorney; property appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized professional organization; or is a person who the nominating member of the Board of Supervisors has reason to believe is possessed of competent knowledge of property appraisal and taxation.

TERM: 3 Year Terms. The term of office of members selected to serve shall be three years beginning on the first Monday in September.

DUTIES: Equalization of taxable value of property.
