COMMITTEE FACT SHEET

NAME: **CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION**

COMPENSATION: \$25.00 per diem with necessary and reasonable traveling expenses.

LEGAL AUTHORITY: County Civil Service Enabling Law, Government Code Section 31100 to and including Section 31116; Title 2, Division 5, Chapter 2, Sections 2-5000 -- 2-5004, 2-5009, 2-5012 -- 2-5014, and 2-5016 -- 2-5017 of the Ordinance Code of San Joaquin; Ordinance #518 1/2 Adopted November 2, 1948 which created and established a Merit System for the County of San Joaquin; Ordinance #761 Adopted November 24, 1958; Ordinance #1272 Adopted September 14, 1965; Ordinance #2113 Adopted January 22, 1974; Ordinance #2548 Adopted May 16, 1978; and Ordinance #4321 Adopted March 20, 2007.

MEMBERSHIP, QUALIFICATIONS, & RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS 5 Members appointed by the Board of Supervisors (1 from each Supervisorial District). The members shall be selected from among the qualified electors of the County. No member of the Civil Service Commission shall hold any other County employment or office, or be a member of any other County Commission, nor shall he have been within one year next preceding his appointment an officer in any political organization.

TERM: 4 Year Terms.

DUTIES: Maintain an equitable and uniform procedure for dealing with personnel matters through a Civil Service Commission and to place County employment on a merit basis for the purpose of obtaining the highest efficiency and assuring that the best qualified persons available shall be brought into the service of the County.
