<b>LEGAL AUTHORITY:</b>	California Government Code Section 26490, Board of Supervisors Resolution #R-86-1184 (Dec 5, 1986), Adopted Bylaws.
<b>MEMBERSHIP, QUALIFICATIONS, RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS:</b>	Number of Members: 5 5 Members: 3 Permanent Members as established by Government Code (County Clerk or designee; County Librarian or designee; and County Museum Director or designee); 2 At-Large members to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors. All members shall be residents of San Joaquin County and shall possess an interest in historic, governmental records. They shall be selected from the following fields: County Government; Library Services; Academic & Other Professionals; Historians; Community History; Historical and Genealogical Societies or Associations; Business and Other Professionals.
<b>TERM:</b>	4 Years. Initial appointees will determine by lot whos first term shall be 2 years and whose term shall be 4 years. Members may be reappointed by the Board of Supervisors. No limitation on reappointment.
<b>DUTIES:</b>	This Commission conducts meetings, hearings, and other activities so as to foster and promote the preservation of historical records. Other duties to be determined.
