COMMITTEE FACT SHEET

NAME: **IN-HOME SUPPORTIVE SERVICES ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

COMPENSATION: None.

LEGAL AUTHORITY: AB 1682, Chapter 90, Statutes of 1999; Board Order B-00-389, Adopted April 4, 2000; and Board Order B-01-915, Adopted July 10, 2001.

MEMBERSHIP, QUALIFICATIONS, & RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS: Eleven (11) Members and Three (3) Alternate Members appointed by the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Six (6) members who live or work in San Joaquin County who are past or present users of personal assistance services, of which:
 - All six (6) must be past or present users of public or private personal assistance services; a minimum of three (3) committee members to be past or present users of public personal assistance services.
- b) Two (2) members will be current or former providers of in-home supportive services.
- c) Three (3) members, who live or work in San Joaquin County, to be selected from the specific categories indicated below.

Categories for non-user members:

 - Personal Assistance Services Individual or Family Provider
 - Personal Assistance Services Contract Provider Representative
 - Social Services Administrative Representative
 - Licensed Medical Professional
 - Senior Advocate
 - Younger Disabled Advocate
 - Health Care Provider Representative
- d) All applicants will be screened by the Human Services Agency for verification that the individual possesses the necessary requirement for that category. The IHSS Public Authority staffs the committee and acts as the lead agency on projects.

TERM: 3 Year Terms. Initial appointments staggered so that six members have a 2 Year Term, and five members have a 3 Year Term.

DUTIES: Submit recommendations to the County Board of Supervisors on the preferred service delivery mode(s) to be utilized by the County for the provision of in-home supportive services.
Provide ongoing advice and recommendations regarding in-home

supportive services to the County Board of Supervisors, any administrative body in the county that is related to the delivery and administration of in-home supportive services, and the governing body and administrative agency of the public authority, non-profit consortium, contractor and public employees.

Once a month or as needed or directed by consensus of the committee members. Times and locations will be based on the needs of the committee. All reasonable accommodations will be made to address individual schedule, accessibility, and transportation needs.
