LEGAL AUTHORITY: Division 4, Part 1, Section 31010 of the Government Code; Section 10515 of the Elections Code; Resolution R-80-977 Adopted June 19, 1980; Resolution R-87-344 Adopted April 28, 1987; AB 3543, Chapter 1161 Approved September 20, 1990; B-12-434 adopting Uniform Rules for Municipal Advisory Councils June 19, 2012; and B-14-753; R-14-186 adopted December 9, 2014.
