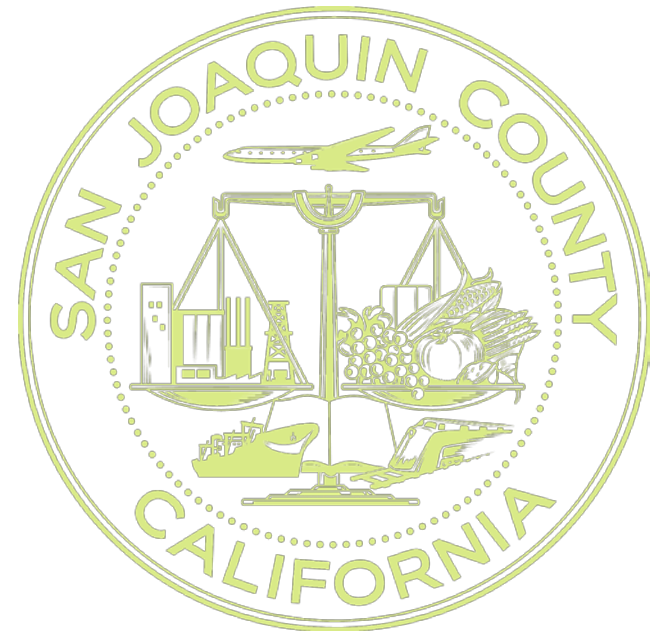

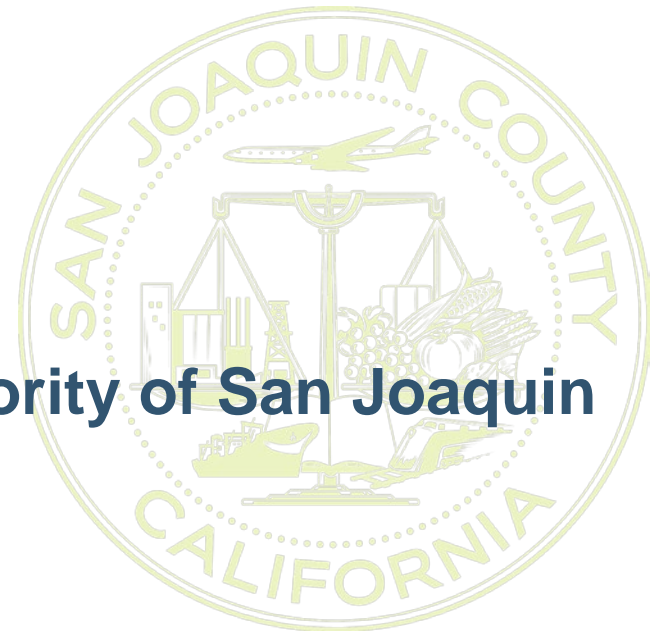


MHSA – Community Services and Supports Project Based Housing and Homelessness Initiatives

August 13, 2019

Project Based Housing:

- **Agreement with Housing Authority of San Joaquin**
- **Total of 35 housing units**
- **Term: 20 years**
- **Funding: MHSA \$3.5 Million**
- **Target Population: Individuals with mental illness**



Project Description:

- **Renovate existing office buildings into new housing units for individuals with mental illnesses with onsite supportive services.**
- **Dedicated to house individuals with mental health concerns for at least 20 years.**
- **Housing vouchers are attached to the unit, not the tenant, which ensures the facility will retain its purpose and focus on this population.**

Current Status:

- **Phase I Crossways Residences at 448 S. Center St. are undergoing renovation.**

Other Homelessness Initiatives:



Whole Person Care:

- **Provide intensive case management and wrap around services for clients**
- **Projected Clients Served: 500**
- **Target Population: Adults enrolled in Medi-Cal who are homeless or at risk of homelessness**
- **Term – 5 years (2016-2020)**
- **Access to medical respite and recuperative care component 15 beds at Gospel Rescue Mission**

MHSA Innovation Programs –

- **Homeward Bound**
 - **Projected Clients Served – 1,000**
 - **\$250K for housing supports to increase the availability of housing for individuals with mental illnesses**
 - **Aligns with the recommendations of the County’s Homelessness Taskforce and the Stepping-up Initiative Steering Committee**



MHSA Innovation Programs –

- **Progressive Housing**
 - **Scattered Site Housing Units – Currently** _____ houses with 6 bedrooms each provide options for both temporary and permanent housing
 - **Target Population: Homeless individuals with mental illness**
 - **Clients Served:**
 - **2018/2019: 50 clients**
 - **2019/2020 projected: 100 clients**
