  - i. April 25<sup>th</sup> there is a public hearing for DPR's proposal for new Neonic regulations at 9:30 a.m. via zoom meeting. Information is available on The Department of Pesticide Regulation website.
  - ii. I am still in discussions with four other counties Sacramento, Yolo, Calaveras and Amador about possible pesticide take back program, hoping to hear about funding next week.
  - iii. There is going to be a meeting with San Joaquin Valley Commissioners with Department of Pesticide Regulation on the 21<sup>st</sup> to discuss 1,3-D or Telone.
  - iv. Received an AgVenture grant, will be taken to the Board in a couple of weeks, we received \$260,000 for the next three years.
  - v. On-line CE program, we have 2,800 users and given out almost 8,600 CE's in the last year in half. The grant will continue through next fiscal year.
  - vi. There are still N95 mask available.
  - vii. Nutria update taken 160 out of Walthall Slough, most of the activity has been on the Stanislaus and San Joaquin border.

- viii. Industrial Hemp update seven people were issued county licenses and state registrations of those one was an outdoor grow that tested at 6% which required us to destroy that crop. We rescinded three other licenses that ended up being indoor hemp grows that were not hemp.
