REGISTER WITH CDFA

- Eligibility – No felony for a controlled substance in last 10 years.
- Cultivation Site(s) – with GPS coordinates (Longitude and Latitude).
- Approved Seed Cultivar
 - Variety (Example – Red Bloom)
 - ISO/DEA approved Lab THC results (under 0.30)
 - Proof of Seller's Registration
 - State/Country of Origin
- State Fee: \$900

SAN JOAQUIN CO. INDUSTRIAL HEMP LICENSE

- AGRICULTURALL ZONE (AG 20)
- OUTDOOR HEMP CULTIVATION
 - 100 ft. from any boundary line of a parcel
 - 1,000 ft. from a parcel containing a sensitive receptor (School, Church, Temple, Synagogue, and etc.)
 - 200 ft. from any residential uses
- INDOOR CULTIVATION OF HEMP
 - 50 ft. from any boundary line of the parcel adjacent
 - 1,000 ft. from a parcel containing a sensitive receptor (School, Church, Temple, Synagogue, and etc.)
 - 100 ft. from any residential uses

COUNTY LICENSE COST

(What is Done?)

- Review license application
 - Contact deed holders
- Review Map (Ag. 20)
- Examine location(s) (physical visit)
 - Check Buffer zones
 - Check for Sensitive Receptors
- Review GPS Coordinates

- Review OpID/RMP – no cost

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Industrial Hemp Cultivation in San Joaquin County

On September 24, 2019, the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors approved the Industrial Hemp Cultivation Ordinance that went into effect on October 25, 2019. Please refer to the PDF document for the requirements pertaining to cultivation of Hemp in San Joaquin County.

California's industrial hemp law can be found in Division 24 of the California Food and Agricultural Code (FAC). The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) has also adopted regulations in Title 3 of the California Code of Regulations pertaining to registration, approved cultivars, sampling and testing, and destruction of noncompliant hemp crops.
