Project Location - Specific: The project site is located on the north side of State Route 26, 2,800' west of Fine Road in Linden. (APN/Address: 091-290-05 / 20999 E. State Route 26, Linden) (Supervisoral District: 4)

Project Description: Minor Subdivision application to subdivide an existing 60.95 acre parcel into 2 parcels. Parcel 1 is 2.0-acres homesite for financing purposes. Parcel 2 is a 58.95-acres designated remainder. This project has direct road access from E State Route. Proposed new lot will have access to Walnut Drive by way of an easement. This parcel can be served by on-site well for water, on-site septic for wastewater disposal, and stormwater drainage. This parcel is under a Williamson Act contract.
