

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

In accordance with Section 15072 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, this notice is to inform the general public that Reclamation District No. 756 has completed an Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the Bouldin Island Multi-benefit Levee Setback Project and intends to adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the project:

Project Title: Bouldin Island Multi-benefit Levee Setback Project

Project Location: Bouldin Island, San Joaquin County

Project Description: Reclamation District No. 756 plans to implement a levee setback on approximately 5,000 linear feet of levee along the Mokelumne River on Bouldin Island to create a waterside planting bench for Shaded Riverine Aquatic habitat, rehabilitate the levee to sustainably meet Bulletin 192-82 standards, and replace the District's Camp 5 Pump Station.

Findings: An Initial Study has been prepared to assess the potential effects of the Project on the environment and the significance of those effects. Based on the Initial Study, Reclamation District No. 756 has determined that the Project, including conservation measures that are part of the Project design, would not have significant effects on the environment.
