Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Interacid North America, Inc., is proposing new construction and modifications at the existing 3.47-acre liquid bulk (sulfuric acid) terminal infrastructure to expand its existing storage, dilution, and transfer capabilities. The work would include structural changes, installation of new process systems, and upgrades to operational controls to support increased capacity, improved reliability, and support higher product throughput. The proposed project would expand and modernize existing terminal infrastructure within its current footprint to improve operational reliability and accommodate a shift toward vessel imports and rail exports.
