**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
RECLAMATION DISTRICT 1007
(PICO & NAGLEE)**

RESOLVED, all repair of wave wash protection, all levee crown restoration which is not in excess of the 100 year flood elevation plus two (2) feet and all levee section restoration, including adding material to back slopes, construction of toe berms, and construction of seepage berms, drains and other measures to control seepage exit gradients to less than 0.5, is hereby found to be exempt pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act. The District Engineer, the District President, the District Secretary or any trustee is hereby authorized to file appropriate Notices of Determination of exemption for projects encompassed within the above determination.
