PROJECT

The Tracy Hills Phase 1C project is the final vacant property north of I-580 and south of the California Aqueduct within the Tracy Hills Specific Plan area. The proposed project includes 289 single-family residential lots, one neighborhood park, five private park facilities and various other parcels to be maintained by the homeowner's association.

The project is consistent with the General Plan land use designation for the property of Residential Medium and the proposed smaller lot development is designed to allow for innovative design for a more affordable housing project. The Phase 1C project will provide a type of housing that will create opportunities for more affordable home ownership for the community. This project helps implement the 2023-2031 Housing Element required by the State.

LOCATION

Phase 1C of the Specific Plan Area encompasses approximately 121.6 acres located generally west of Phase 1B, south of the California Aqueduct and north of Interstate 580. (APN: 251-040-08 and 251-040-19)

CEQA DETERMINATION

An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was certified by the City Council on April 5, 2016, for the Tracy Hills Specific Plan (2013102053) in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the CEQA Guidelines. An Initial Study and EIR Consistency Analysis was prepared for the General Plan Amendment and Tracy Hills Specific Plan Amendment to change the land use designations on Tracy Hills Phase 1B and Phase 1C from non-residential to residential, which was approved by the City Council on November 10, 2020. No new significant environmental impacts were identified for the project. The Tracy Hills Phase 1C project is consistent with the EIR for the Tracy Hills Specific Plan. Therefore, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15162 and 15168(c)(2), no further environmental review is necessary.

The Project site is located on approximately 2,732 acres within the southwestern portion of the City of Tracy in San Joaquin County, in the vicinity of the existing Corral Hollow Road interchange and the future Lammers Road interchange with Interstate 580. The property is bordered by the Delta Mendota Canal to the north, the Union Pacific Railroad to the north, hillsides used for livestock grazing to the west and southwest, Corral Hollow Road to the southeast, and privately owned lands designated and zoned for aggregate extraction to the east.

Project Description:

The Tracy Hills Specific Plan Project, is anticipated to include the development of up to 5,499 residential dwelling units, over five million square feet of non-residential development, and related infrastructure to support the public and private improvements of the Project. The Project area was originally annexed into the City of Tracy ("City") in 1998. The Project that is the subject of this Notice of Determination consists of a comprehensive update to the Tracy Hills Specific Plan and a Development Agreement that applies to the area of the Tracy Hills Specific Plan owned by the Project applicant, Tracy Hills Project Owner, LLC.

On April 5, 2016, after considering all the aspects of the Project, the City Council approved the Tracy Hills Specific Plan Project by (1) certifying the Final Subsequent Environmental Impact Report ("SEIR") prepared for the project, making findings of fact, findings related to alternatives, adopting a statement of overriding considerations, and adopting a mitigation monitoring and reporting program in connection with the same; (2) approving a General Plan Amendment (GPA 13-0001); (3) approving the comprehensive update to the Tracy Hills Specific Plan (SPA 13-0001); (4) introducing for first reading of Ordinance No. 1212 to amend to the Tracy Municipal Code to add the Tracy Hills Specific Plan Zone (ZA 13-0003); (5) approving a comprehensive update to the Tracy Hills Storm Drainage Master Plan; (6) introducing for first reading Ordinance No. 1213 to adopt a development agreement (DA 13-0001); (7) approving a large-lot Vesting
