Project Description: Time Extension application a previously approved Site Approval to develop a warehouse and distribution facility to include construction of a 231,340 sq. ft building, a 281,710 sq. ft. building, and a 166,320 sq. ft. building. Total sq. ft. is 679,370. The project proposes the utilization of a private well for water, an onsite septic system for sewage disposal, and three 3 on site retention basins for storm drainage. All existing equipment buildings will be demolished. The project site has direct access to West Schulte Road.
