Project Description/Location: The project involves establishing a Red-Light Camera Enforcement Program at select signalized intersections within the City of Mountain House, San Joaquin County, California. The program includes installation of automated enforcement cameras and related signage within public rights-of-way to enhance traffic safety. All work will occur within developed roadway corridors and will not expand roadway capacity or alter existing land use.




